However, most of my experience came with a drama group founded by my mother where I acted, playing such roles as Beverly in *Abigail's Party*, Ruth in *Blithe Spirit*, and Patricia in *Wild Goose Chase*! I also got my opportunity to direct whilst there but then life got in the way and it wasn't until I joined MLT just a few years ago that I found out how much I still enjoyed acting although most of my time is spent in the very important role of dispensing tea, coffee and ice cream in intervals!

I will be honest: I was really surprised, and thrilled, to have been asked to direct a play this season and it has been really good fun. The large cast and I have squeezed into tiny, cold rehearsal rooms to perfect, hopefully, the timing that will bring this funny, fast-paced farce to life for you.

Farce in the winter takes me back to sitting with the family on Boxing Day, watching the Whitehall Farce with Brian Rix. I recall there was always mistaken identity, underpants, doors and a good chase to make me laugh so I hope this offering brings the same smile to you!

I am indebted to my hardworking cast and also the unsung heroes of every production, our talented backstage team of set builders, painters, technicians and indeed the entire crew who help bring our plays to life.

He wrote his first play in his early twenties, the family comedy *Young at Heart* which opened at the Preston Hippodrome and toured to many of the UK's repertory theatres. He wrote around 25 full-length plays including *Caught on the Hop, Bedside Manners*, a box office hit which starred John Inman and ran in the West End for over a year, and *Beyond a Joke*, a similar success starring Arthur Lowe. His plays were very popular in many parts of Europe including 1982's *Touch and Go* which, in a translation, enjoyed an 18-month run in Paris. The play is often revived in Europe and a new Greek translation proved a hit in Athens in 2011.

Wild Goose Chase opened at the New Theatre, Hull, on 28 June 1954 and in October that year transferred to the Embassy Theatre in Swiss Cottage, now part of the Central School of Speech & Drama campus, where it enjoyed a long, successful run. The play, along with its sequel, Post Horn Gallop, continues to prove extremely popular especially amongst amateur companies. Our youth company presented Wild Goose Chase in the spring of 2003 as part of our 45th season in a production directed by Hazel Charlesworth.

Derek Benfield once said, 'My family are delighted with my success as a playwright, as it helps to prop up my tottering career as an actor!' He died on 10 March 2009 in Esher, Surrey, on the eve of his 83rd birthday, following a long illness.
